We invite all participants to submit proposals to present at the spring conference, which will be held in-person at Daytona State College. With the [goals of Curriculum Alignment](#) and transfer student success in mind, the theme of this year's conference explores how faculty instructional practices align to the new realities institutions face in a post-pandemic and ever-changing academic climate. The conference will feature three concurrent presentation tracks, which are:

Track 1: Multiple Modalities of Instruction

Sessions in this include topics that discuss instructional/ pedagogical approaches or exploration of how to best serve the current and future students. Topics may include effective instructional applications for use with, for, or by different students, disciplines or institutions; challenges and opportunities using various modes of instructions; or improving student engagement while embracing online technologies.

Track 2: Authentic Assessments

Sessions in this track may address a variety of approaches and challenges to assessment, including meeting state or local mandates, affirming effectiveness of instructional mode, and ensuring learning/ course objectives are aligned.

Track 3: Using Data for Student Success

Sessions in this track will focus on examples or best practices of how to use data to inform curricular or pedagogical practices in aligned (or aligning) courses as well as demonstrations of data that show the impact of aligned curriculum.

Presentations will be given live and in a format of the presenter's choosing during a 45 minute session. Presentations can be in any form (e.g., lecture, panel, activity, etc.) and may be supplemented with infographics, video clips, Powerpoint, or any other supporting materials. We strongly encourage that your presentation includes an interactive learning component.
